

## How to connect to Friday's Shabbat and Saturday Morning Shabbat service:

The ideal devices to log in are:

- A computer with a microphone and camera (most laptops have this pre-installed)
- A tablet, such as an iPad, which also has audio/video capabilities
- A smartphone

How to prepare for the service:

Lighting candles – Light Shabbat candles as usual before sundown. Services will begin after sundown.

Oneg – At the end of the service, we will say Kiddush over the wine and HaMotzi over bread. If you'd like to have your own cup of wine or juice ready, as well as some bread/challah, or your favorite snack, you can take a sip or a bite when we bless.

Prayerbook – Our congregation uses *Siddur Sim Shalom* as its prayerbook. The books themselves are stored at the synagogue, but not to worry! You can follow along in the following way:

- **Screen share** – anyone logged into Zoom will **automatically be able to see a copy of the prayers** on your device during the service
